Welcome

As we move through winter, I am very happy to share with you some of the awesome things that YourPlace Housing has been doing during the past six months, as we ensure our services and housing options are constantly improving.

One of the most important things we can do is listen to what you have to say and involve you in our decisions. That is why we had our first tenant scrutineer meeting in May, where we invited tenants who had been relocated through our redevelopment program to tell us what they thought about that process and what we could improve. We learned a lot from our tenants, and we will use these learnings in our future plans.

We also undertook a project with some of our tenants in supported accommodation to find out how they felt about their shared accommodation and what kind of housing options they wanted for the future. The results of this project will help us to create more suitable and accessible homes for our tenants who require daily support in their homes.

I thank all the tenants and their families who joined in these two initiatives, as well as those who filled out our tenant engagement survey last year. Your feedback is invaluable and helps us to improve how we meet your needs.

I am also excited to tell you that we have finished another three two-bedroom

properties at Pasadena, with five more coming up in Valley View. These new properties will give more affordable and quality housing for our tenants, as well as make the local communities more lively and friendly. We have also received funding from the South Australian Housing Authority to build another six properties in Klemzig and O'Sullivan Beach.

With these new homes, we will have built 31 new properties by the end of 2025. This is a fantastic achievement, especially when construction continues to get more expensive across Adelaide. We are thankful for the help and cooperation of the South Australian Government, as well as our contractors and suppliers, who have made it possible for us to finish these projects on time and on budget.

I hope you enjoy reading this newsletter and finding out more about what's going on at YourPlace Housing. I look forward to seeing you and hearing from you over the next six months.

Turtle Power - Pet Profile

Some people like dogs, some people like cats, and other people, like our tenants Donna and Lola, like turtles!



INTRODUCING INCABUS - THE 22-YEAR-OLD LONG-NECKED TURTLE.

You may think that looking after a turtle is easy and low maintenance but it is quite the opposite.

Donna takes a lot of time and care when it comes to Incabus and his care. His shell is cleaned regularly, which is done with brown vinegar and cotton balls to remove any build up, there are also calcium blocks put into his tank so that his shell stays strong and healthy.

Much like us, turtles need vitamin D, and the best way to get this is outside in the sunshine. Incabus is taken out of his tank regularly to stroll around the backyard. Donna watches him carefully as turtles can move extremely fast, not to mention the magpies that like to swoop and taunt him while he is out getting his exercise, which usually causes Incabus to retreat back into his shell for protection.

Incabus' favourite foods include frozen squares of turtle food from the pet shop, blood worms and the Aluminium plant, which is in his tank to nibble on.

These beautiful reptiles start off the size of a 50 cent piece, gradually growing to the size that Incabus is now - about the size of a dinner plate. It takes long-necked turtles around 7-9 years to reach adult size and they can live up to 50 years!!

TOMATO SOUP

PREPARATION TIME: 25 MINS

SERVES: 6

COST PER SERVING: \$2.95

INGREDIENTS

- 2 x Carrots
- 2 x Sticks of Celery
- 2 x Medium Onions
- 2 x Cloves of Garlic
- 2.5ml Olive Oil (½tsp)
- 2 x Reduced Salt Chicken or Vegetable Stock Cubes
- 2 x 400g Tins of Tomatoes
- 6 x Ripe Tomatoes
- 7.5g Fresh Basil

DIRECTIONS

- Peel and roughly slice carrots, slice celery and peel and chop onions, slice garlic.
- 2 Heat 2 tablespoons of oil in a large pan over medium heat. Add the carrots, celery, onions and garlic. Cook with lid ajar for 10–15 minutes, until softened.
- 3 Crumble stock cubes into a jug and add 1.5 litres of boiling water. Stir until dissolved.
- 4 Add stock to pan with tin tomatoes and fresh whole tomatoes. Bring to the boil and reduce to a simmer for 10 minutes with the lid on.
- 5 Remove pan from heat and season with salt and pepper.
- 6 Stir through basil leaves.
- 7 Blend with stick blender until smooth.
